The company provides recreational and historical tours of their 4,000 acre ranch property, spread from the steep mountain cliffs to the sparkling sea. Many guests are from Japan and China. Located on the northeastern side of Oahu, it is less than an hour from Honolulu. The ranch terrain varies from dense rainforest to broad open valleys and from beautiful white sand beaches to verdant cliff faces.

The ranch has been the site of many television shows and Hollywood films such as *Jurassic Park*, *Windtalkers*, *Pearl Harbor*, *Godzilla*, *Tears of the Sun* and *50 First Dates*. TV shows include *Hawaii Five-O*, *Magnun P.I.* and most recently the hit show *LOST*. It is truly a paradise for outdoor recreation with many places accessible with horseback, on tour bus or by hiking.

- To apply for a trainee program, you must hold a hospitality or business management degree and at least 1 year of work experience, OR be a career professional of 5 or more years of hospitality or business management experience (maximum duration – 12 months for hospitality management, 18 months for business management)
- Bi-lingual in Japanese or Chinese and in English
- Have a drivers license
- Willing to work outdoors
